Thank you for your interest in the Penn Hockey Program! Located near the heart of Philadelphia, the University of Pennsylvania's historic and picturesque campus holds an undergraduate student body of nearly 10,000, hailing from every state in the union and all around the globe. As an Ivy League school with highly selective admissions and a history of innovation in interdisciplinary education and scholarship, Penn consistently ranks among the top 10 universities in the annual U.S. News & World Report survey.

In addition to the educational benefits of obtaining your degree from an Ivy League school, Penn is likewise an excellent place to continue your competitive hockey career. As an ACHA DII Club Team, we play a roughly thirty-game season from September through February against schools like Princeton University, St. Joseph's University, and Wagner College. Our roster is comprised of players from a variety of hockey backgrounds; for example, before coming to Penn, some competed at the Junior level, others played high school hockey, and still others competed at the travel/club level.

During the season, we practice between two to three times per week at the Class of 1923 Arena, located on campus. We also complete one additional off-ice workout at the 19,000 square-foot David Pottruck Fitness & Wellness Center. Although the season is undoubtedly demanding, the players always find time for their academics and often find time to engage in other extra-curricular activities.
